

# ORCA—OCEAN RIDGE SUPPORTS THE CAROUSEL CHILD **ADVOCACY CENTER**

In October, Ocean Ridge Charities Association (ORCA) invited the Ocean Ridge community to attend the Carousel Child Advocacy Center's "Inaugural Everyday Hero Award and Luncheon". This was an opportunity to learn what the Carousel Center does and to see how they assist those in Brunswick County affected by childhood sexual abuse.

ORCA would like to thank the community for their generous donations to the Carousel Child Advocacy Center. Many Ocean Ridge residents attended the luncheon while others made a donation in support of the cause.

Ocean Ridge's participation definitely helped in their efforts, as we raised \$2,030. Together... guests, hosts, sponsors and donors contributed almost \$20,000 in much-needed funding to provide services and programs for Brunswick county children.

The Brunswick County Sheriff's Office was honored for its exceptional commitment to child sexual abuse prevention and its achievement of the International honor of Partner in Prevention designation, which recognizes organizations that ensure more than 90% of their staff is trained in this critical area.

The Sheriff's Office exceeded this benchmark, with 323 officers completing a rigorous three-hour workshop. This makes them the first law enforcement agency in our region—and the largest in North Carolina—to invest significantly in preventing abuse and protecting children. This achievement underscores their dedication to creating a safer community. By earning the Partner in Prevention designation, the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office has demonstrated leadership that transcends traditional policing.

Many other Brunswick County organizations are also involved in training their staffs.
