

DID YOU KNOW....that last Autumn's MADD (Make a Difference Day) sponsored by ORCA (Ocean Ridge Charities Association) would not have gotten off the ground without two families (non-ORCA Members) stepping forward to support the program.

The program raised nearly \$20,000 worth of golf balls, clothing and equipment presented to 6 different thrift shops and earned the organization a \$10,000 award. It was an amazing tribute to our community as many of our neighbors stepped forward giving their time and assets to make this program such a great success.

MADD is a nation-wide program sponsored by three foundations -**Tegna**, a subsidiary of Comcast

(formerly Gannett Newspapers), Arby's Foundation and George H. W. Bush's

Points of Light campaign. They award \$10,000 to each

organization that comes up with unique programs to help the needy. Last year, our MADD effort was one of 13 National \$10,000 prize winners from over 800 programs considered. Members of ORCA discussed various ideas to engage the community in a day of service. One was collecting used golf balls from the community and donating them to charity thrift stores in the area. The team thought that maybe they might collect as many as 10,000 used

golf balls, although some thought that was a stretch. To test the possibility they sent out a few e-mails to people they thought might have extra golf balls stashed away. The email explained the idea and asked 3 questions: 1) Do you think this is a good idea? 2) Would you be prepared to donate golf balls? 3) If so how many?

Two gentlemen responded – Carl Schuster with 1500 balls and Glenn Hess with 500. They delivered them, cleaned and bagged, thanks to the help of their brides. Glenn even had his sorted and bagged in dozens! 2000 balls from two respondents—ORCA was astounded and decided to push forward with the program. The program was expanded to include golfing attire and equipment. Eventually the event amassed over 26,000 golf balls and heaps other golf equipment donated from the community.

It took a full day (The Make A Difference Day of Service) with over 100 Ocean Ridge volunteers needed to sort, grade and bag them for easy sale. It proved a fantastic success but one that would have not occurred if Carl and Glenn had not responded so positively. Thank you Carl and Glenn!

ORCA is planning its second MADD on the October 27, 2018 with a different theme (we've thinned out or depleted our garages of used golf equipment). This year the theme is Helping Hands for the Homeless and collection of needed items has already started. Do watch for the announcements and if you can contribute and help, please do so that Make A Difference Day will be another special and successful event for our caring Ocean Ridge community.
